Workshop on PSYCHOACTIVE SUBSTANCE USE AND SUICIDE: PREVENTION AND ROLE OF THE NURSE

Substance use and depressive disorders often coexist, with associated risk for suicide. Substance use is a modifiable risk factor for suicide, particularly among key populations (such as youth). Nurses work with individuals in various settings 24 hours a day. They are therefore important members of the health team who are in a prime position to recognize signs of depression and risk for suicide, and provide necessary interventions in a timely manner.

Objective

To enable nurses to intervene effectively with individuals using psychoactive substances with associated depression and suicidal risk, with a focus on key populations
