About the Course

Adolescence is an age of opportunity for children, and a pivotal time for us to build on their development in the formative years of their life, to help them navigate risks and vulnerabilities, and to set them on the path to fulfilling their potentials. The process of growing and adjusting to changing surroundings, coping with the pressure of academics and increasing competition, tension of social relations with peer group and parents, are all serious challenges and threats to the mental health of adolescents. Involving in risk taking behaviours to become a part of the peer group and to gain their approval is a common feature of early adolescence. Many of the mental, behavioural and psychological problems among children and adolescents can be prevented if it is intervened at an early stage through enhancing their life skills.

About the Course

The Promotion of Mental Health & Life Skills Education for Adolescents is a universal comprehensive promotive school mental health programme designed to reduce risks and enhance psychosocial competencies and resiliency of adolescents in schools. It is universal as it applies to all the students. This program is an outcome of collaborative research Government of Karnataka and Department of Psychiatric Social Work, NIMHANS. It focus on training of schools and college teachers, school counsellors, social workers and other non-health care professionals as life skills facilitators. So far nearly 700 participants have been trained as Life Skills Facilitators and program has reached entire district of primary and secondary school children of Kolar District of Karnataka.

It is an interactive, skills-based program designed to promote positive health and psychological well-being of adolescents using teachers, school counsellors, educators, doctors, social workers, nurses, and other health professional as life skills facilitators in the schools and colleges. The program addresses the various developmental, behavioural and psychological issues and concerns of adolescents that affect their overall health and resilience. Empowerment of adolescents with life skills is the GOAL. The programme promotes psychosocial competencies of adolescents.

Aim:

- To train the health and non-health care professionals as life skills educators.
- Building capacity of the participants to apply the life skills education in different settings.

Course Learning Objectives:

- Understanding the theoretical foundation, concept of life skills education and importance in promotion of mental health and well-being of adolescents.
- Learning various teaching methodologies in application of life skills education
- Application of life skills education for promotion of mental health and wellbeing of individual using different teaching methodologies.
- Learning to develop life skills education modules for various psychosocial issues of individual in the society in the contexts such as school children, colleges, NGOs, youth organizations, vulnerable groups such as institutionalized children, street children, differently abled, and adolescents with illness such as HIV/AIDS etc. and children in conflict with law.

Course Coverage:

The course will include hands on participatory skills-based training on issues of children and adolescents using life skills approach, concept of WHO life skills and health promotion and preventive model, life skills teaching methodologies, facilitation skills, assessment and evaluation of life skills training, program sharing of NIMHANS promotive mental health and life skills modules, training and designing program in the context of children and adolescents issues in different settings.

No of Seats: Maximum 5 seats for each batch

Course Duration: Three months full-time, on campus at NIMHANS

Fee Payable: As per NIMHANS rules Rs. 9000/ for Non-medicals candidate and Rs 30,000 medical background candidate for the three months.
