The important dates with respect to the above are as follows:

a. Issue of application forms from : 07.10.2020 b. Last date for Submission of application without fine : 14.10.2020 : 16.10.2020

c. Last date for Submission of Application with additional fine of Rs.50/-

Please Note:

- 1. As per the decision of the Competent Authority, the exit examination will be conducted in paperless/ digital mode for all courses and therefore, Admission cards / Hall tickets will not be issued to students. However, every student should register with biometric during Training session and Practice session to appear for theory Exit Examinations.
- 2. Provisional Dates for conduct of Exit Examination are between 05.11.2020 to 13.11.2020.
- 3. Students who have less than 80% attendance / non-completion of Clinical or any other course requirements certification, will not be allowed to take up the examination.
- 4. If a student does not appear for exam after applying, it will be treated as one "attempt".
- 5. The Examination fees once paid will not be refunded or re-adjusted under any circumstances.
- 6. The unsuccessful students/ repeaters of previous batch admissions (Superspeciality Part II / Mid exam OR PG Non-Medical courses] who have not applied for Part I/Part II /Part III exit exams during June 2020, can apply for November 2020 exit examinations by furnishing permission letter through proper channel with reason for not appearing earlier. Also, they should pay the examination fees as mentioned in the prospectus 2020-21 through SB Collect Portal available on the NIMHANS Website and affix the payment receipt along with their Application Form before submission. Kindly refer to 'Instructions to students regarding remittance of Fees through SB Collect'
- 7. The unsuccessful students/ repeaters of B.Sc. courses have to submit separate application and must mention clearly about their failed subjects of previous years/exams for which they are re-appearing for examinations. B.Sc. Students appearing for Final Year (III Year for B.Sc. in Anaesthesia Technology and B.Sc. in Radiography Courses & IV Year for B.Sc. in Nursing Course) have to enclose copies of all previous years markscards with Exam Application Form.
- 8. The duly filled-in application forms affixed with stamp size photographs should be routed through the respective HOD. Applications will not be accepted after the due date.
- 9. If a student does not plan to appear for exit examination, he/ she has to submit a written request with a genuine reason and route it through the concerned HOD/ Principal with specific remarks/ recommendations. Such letters should reach the undersigned on or before 14.10.2020.
- 10. The payment towards issue of marks card (not applicable to MD, DM & M.Ch. courses) will be collected at one time i.e., when students appear for a Part/Year in '1st attempt'. Hence, the unsuccessful student (of Non-Medical/ B.Sc. courses) are exempted from the remitting markscard fees and a consolidated/ comprehensive marks card to such students after successful completion of that particular exam (Part I /Part II Exit Exam OR I Year / II Year Exit Exam) will be issued with month & year of passing.
- 11. Intimation with regards to various activities related to digital/ paperless exams like conduct of Training Session for students, Mock Test and Practise Sessions will be shared in due course with the respective Depts.
