OVERVIEW

- This is a 3-month online course for qualified Clinical Psychologists and Psychiatrists.
- The training will include didactic interactive online sessions, case presentations (conceptualization and treatment planning), online case discussions, and video demonstrations.
- Training will also require submission of a case report, where cases are conceptualized and managed using the CBT framework. There will be an exit exam at the end of the course which the candidates have to clear to obtain the course completion certificate.

COMPLETING THIS COURSE WILL HELP YOU TO:

- Acquire an understanding of the aims and principles of Cognitive Behaviour Therapy (CBT).
- Understand the various methods of assessment for therapy and basic case formulation of common mental health conditions.
- Plan interventions based on principles of CBT, which will include, structuring a session and building a therapeutic alliance, identifying the appropriate techniques based on the case formulation.
- Acquire an understanding of basic techniques such as arousal reduction, methods of eliciting negative automatic thoughts and dysfunctional assumptions, and modification of these beliefs.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA TO APPLY FOR THE COURSE:

- 1. Two-year full-time regular M.Phil. in Clinical Psychology from an RCI recognized Institute.
- 2. Psychiatrists who have completed their MD and are preferably employed.
- **3.** Candidates can indicate if they have completed a basic Diploma in Mental Health from the NIMHANS Digital Academy.

MODE OF ADMISSION & COURSE FEE:

- Selection of suitable candidates will be based on fulfilment of the eligibility criteria.
- Online applications will be sought from the applicants.
- Short-listed candidates will be selected based on their qualifications, on a first-come-first served basis.
- Only after confirmation of selection by the course coordinator, candidates must complete payment of course fee.

IS IT RECOGNIZED?

- 8. Introduction to mindfulness and its applications in the context of mental health.
