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BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE COURSE

The course is designed to enhance theoretical and practical knowledge of social work practice in community mental health. The course deals with topics that help in identifying the mental disorders, psychosocial issues associated with those disorders and psychosocial treatment procedures. Additionally, the course will provide a base for family, couple, children; group and community based psychosocial interventions in preventive and promotive aspects.

- 2. To enhance the knowledge on psychosocial intervention for persons with mental illness at individual, family and community level
- 3. To learn various preventive and promotive strategies in the field of mental health

MODE OF DELIVERY OF THE COURSE

Blended learning: Self-paced e-learning (Anytime) + Interactive Virtual sessions (Real Time)

Self-paced E-learning (elearn.nimhans.ac.in): Each participant will have access to a Learning Management Solution (example: Moodle app). The relevant contents will be delivered through this app. These will be in the form of recorded video, selected text books, articles, videos, power points etc.

Live Interactive Sessions: Live interactive Sessions will be conducted through NIMHANS multipoint video conferencing platform on every Wednesday 11am-12:30pm. The meeting will be locked at 11:15am. Hence do join before that. This can be accessible through any smartphone, tablet, desktop or laptop. The purposes of these sessions are:

- b. Psychosocial Assessment discussions
- c. Didactic lecture by NIMHANS faculty on specific topics
